

Personal Effects from the Hotel Montana

Kenyon International Emergency Services was given a small amount of personal effects that were discovered during recovery work at the Hotel Montana. Most of these items are associated with known victims and were cleaned, prepared and given to the home government of the individual for return to families. However, Kenyon has five pieces of personal effects that can not be linked to anyone.

Kenyon would like to return these items to the families because it is important to have something that belonged to a loved one who did not come home.

Below are descriptions of the personal effects from the Hotel Montana:

- A blue cloth lanyard key ring with four keys, a school name on it attached to a memorial tag with the date 1985-2005.
- A man's ring with red stone
- Bronze men's watch
- A Mercedes-Benz key ring with keys
- A man's ring with a blue stone

Claiming Procedures

A family or individual wishing to claim these items must provide one or more of the following:

- A) A receipt showing the purchase of the item
- B) A photograph of the item
- C) Any additional description of the item in question.
